# iCare New Free Program for Caregivers



We are seeking caregivers of individuals with Alzheimer's disease or other dementia, to participate in a free program, and help us to develop and evaluate materials on caregiving.

Our goal is to develop a training program to help caregivers to overcome stressful situations related to caregiving, enhance skills to deal with caregiving, alleviate stress, and improve quality of life.

This research program is developed by Photozig and Stanford University, and it is funded by the National Institute on Aging.

### You are eligible to start enrollment if you are:

- Caregiving for a person with Alzheimer's or other dementia.
- Age 21 or over, and have access to a DVD player or the Internet.

### What to expect:

- Fill out an enrollment form/informed consent.
- 2 surveys (over 3 months) to evaluate materials on caregiving.
- Web-based self learning (no face-to-face meetings, appointments, etc). You can live anywhere in the US.
- Free DVD and printed material.
- Compensation of \$50, after completing the program.
- Our online course (developed by this project) will be available for participants at the end of the study (free of charge for one year).
